

## The Concept

- ✓ Upgrading the current 4-lane stone track to a **6-lane synthetic track**
- ✓ Conversion of current grass field into **artificial turf**, with dimensions and lining for football, soccer (also cross-field soccer) and field hockey
- ✓ Development of a **high jump apron**
- ✓ Construction of a **long jump and triple jump facility**
- ✓ New **scoreboard**
- ✓ **LED lighting** for sports field
- ✓ **Spectator seating** for a capacity of 200

Long Jump/Triple Jump Facility

Paris District High School was built in 1923, with additions in 1953 and 1968. The original track and field facilities are still serving students and the Paris community 100 years later, but needs improvements and modernization.
