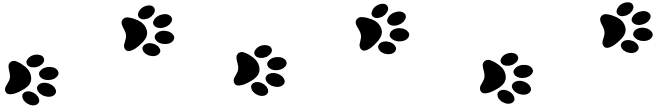

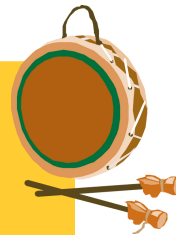


DRAMA CLUB NEWS
