Grand Erie District School Board Seeks Input from Community on 2019-20 Budget

Brantford Ont. – As part of its 2019-20 Budget Consultation Process, Grand Erie District School Board is seeking input from a wide-range of stakeholders in preparing the Board's budget for the upcoming school year.

The 2019-20 Budget Survey, which opens today (March 18) and closes April 15, will gather information from students, staff, parents, school councils and community members. Reponses will help the Board identify priority areas for 2019-20 as well as those moving forward.

"It's important for us to hear from all of our stakeholders," said Rafal Wyszynski, Superintendent of Business and Treasurer for Grand Erie. "Their input is critical and plays a key role in shaping our decisions as we examine all areas of the budget for next year."

A similar Budget Survey was conducted last winter in advance of the 2018-19 budget.

Grand Erie's 2019-20 budget will be presented to the Board of Trustees in June for final review and input.
