The Above and Beyond award is given to an individual on an annual basis. The award's criteria considers the broader school board community. It highlights individuals who support administrators in a variety of ways; those who act in an open and transparent manner; and those who value the contributions administrators make.

"In her role as Director over the past four years, Brenda has worked to create a truly collaborative environment," said Dean. "Whatever the concern, whatever the discussion, she has a unique ability to be fully present during these conversations."

Blancher's contributions include the creation of the Principal/Vice-Principal Wellness Committee, on which she takes an active role.

Grand Erie's Multi-Year Plan includes commitments to both Well-Being, which prioritizes fostering healthy and enabling environments, as well as Achievement, which sets high expectations for staff, monitoring, measuring, and reflecting on outcomes.

"I'm incredibly honoured and humbled by this recognition," said Blancher. "Each and every day, our Principals are focused on supporting our students and staff to ensure success. They manage everything from scheduling and staffing to parent concerns and overall student achievement and well-being.
