Nutrition Breaks and Supervision

All Grand Erie elementary schools are on a balanced school day. This means your child will have two nutritional breaks during the day. Student are to remain at school for the first break (11:00 – 11:40) but may go home during the second break (1:20 – 2:00) only if they have the nutritional break/activity period information form signed and returned. Students will not be permitted to leave the school premises without written parental consent.

Supervision in the morning begins at 8:50. For safety reasons, please do not send your child to school before 8:50. The school day begins at 9:00 and ends at 3:20. All students are expected to be in their classroom before morning announcements begin to not miss important information and learning time. It is also expected that all students head home shortly after the dismissal bell. We do ask that if students are returning to the school property to do so after 4:00 with permission from a parent or guardian.

All students are reminded to us the sidewalks to enter and exit the school property and avoid cutting through the staff parking lot.

Absences and Lates

If you child is going to be late or absent, please call the school office or send a note in your child's agenda.

Vising During School Hours

It is imperative that all visitors to the building report to the main office. All entrance doors to the school are locked during school hours. Please push the buzzer at the front door to notify the office of your arrival. Visitors are not permitted to the classrooms to limit the disruption of both staff and students.

Drop offs and Pick ups

When students are arriving to school or leaving at dismissal, the area around the school is very busy. If you are driving, please **do not** use the staff parking lot and/or the bus loading zones. There is to be no movement in the staff parking lot from 8:50-9:05 and 3:10-3:30. Pylons will be out to keep vehicles from entering or exiting. Please use the parking lot at Queensway Baptist Church as an alternative safe parking area. And please use extra caution.



Adult crossing guards are located at the intersections of St. George St. and Queensway Dr. and Queensway Dr. and Franklin St.

Allergies and Emergency Information

There are several students at James Hillier with allergies to certain foods such as peanuts, tree nuts, seeds, dairy products and eggs to name a few. For some, this may be a life threating situation if they come in contact or ingest some of these foods.
