## We will be working on.....

© Reading: the difference between fiction and non-fiction books, text features (eg. glossary, index, table of contents, bold font, etc.)

© Writing: journal writing, short paragraphs

☺ Word Work: short o, u, sounds, long a and e sounds

③ Math: - rounding two digit numbers to the nearest 10, identifying and describing repeating patterns and growing and shrinking patterns, measuring length, distance around objects, and area

☺ Science – Growth and Change in Animals

© Art: Line – different types (horizontal, vertical, diagonal, pointy, curvy), different varieties (thick, thin, dotted), lines inside of shapes

## Weekly Spelling Test

Just a reminder about properly formed letters in our words on our spelling tests. After each dictation, I remind the students to look for capital letters in the middle of words. I also remind them to check for any backwards letters, by using their alphabet chart on their name tags.

We are also practicing these skills during printing time as well as, when we write in our journals and agendas.
