## Winter Clothing

Avoid boots or coats with removable liners. Also, label your child's clothing - especially snow pants since many snow pants look similar.

#### **Running Shoes**

Now that the children are wearing boots, make sure you send shoes to wear inside. These shoes can stay at school and will be kept in the cubbies.

Please remember to check your child's Teddy File after each school day and help your child remember to return it to school every day.
