Curriculum

In math, we are continuing our Math unit on Data Management. We are learning to read data from a variety of graphs and learning how to display data on pictographs and bar graphs.

Coming soon... multiplication!! During class time, we will be practicing our times tables through games and activities. Please encourage and help your child to study and practice their facts to 9x9. Knowing our multiplication facts are the building blocks to many math concepts. There are many ways to do this such as flash cards, card games, online games and plain old memorization.

A fun and easy card game to play is Dueling Products, a game similar to War.

Rules: Deal out all the cards to 2 players (remove the kings and queens) keeps the jokers they are zero.

Players flip over one card at a time. The first player to correctly multiply the two cards wins the cards. The object is to try and win all your opponents cards.

To add difficulty to the games include the queens as 11 and kings as 12.

In language, we have started our new reading unit on visualization. During this unit we will be using our brains to imagine the story in our minds and add extra details using our senses. IN WRITING, WE ARE JUST BEGINNING A UNIT ON IMAGINED NARRATIVES. I CAN'T WAIT TO READ ABOUT ALL THE INTERESTING CHARACTERS AND STORYLINES THE CHILDREN CREATE.
