Kindergarten Registration

With the new year we begin our Kindergarten Registration. Children who will be four by the end of December 2020 are eligible for Junior Kindergarten and children who will be five by the end of December are eligible for Senior Kindergarten beginning in September.


Early learning is so important for our children. Our kindergarten program provides a caring setting for developing social skills in a learning environment rich in early language and mathematics opportunities.

Reminders from the Office:

- ⇒ The roundabout at the front of the school is for our Special Education Students and Buses ONLY. Even in bad weather this must be kept clear at <u>all</u> times!!
- ⇒ Students MUST wear footwear in the halls at ALL times.
- ⇒ We have a lot of students coming in late. School starts at 9 a.m. sharp. It is very important that students arrive before this time and go into the school with their class.
- ⇒ Supervision starts at 8:40 a.m. and no students should be on the school yard before that time.
