## Curriculum Connections:

Language: Making Inferences: Students are learning to "*read between the lines"* and draw conclusions about the text. Teachers on staff have been super creative and kind, writing mystery letters so we can guess who they are. Students are amazing at this! Many use deductive reasoning to rule out who it is not. Smarty Pants! Clue, Guess Who and Headbandz are great board games to play!

Writing: Connecting to reading...students will be writing Mini Mystery stories over the next two weeks. They always love this unit!

Math: Money amounts to \$10. Making Change and Adding. Geometry - 2D Shapes / 3D Shapes

Science: Strong and Stable Structures - Students are having so much fun using problem solving skills to design structures that are able to support light loads, using a variety of materials.
