Last month upgrades were made to Ryerson's HVAC system. Highlights of the upgrades include...

• The installation of seven LED-UV air purification units with in the school's HVAC systems

- The units are proven to kill 99.9% of viruses, bacteria and mould by eliminating airborne and surface contaminates. It also works against COVID-19.
- There are no harmful by-products: as they are both mercury free and zero ozone compliant.

Similar units are being installed at various schools throughout the Board.
