PIZZA PROGRAM PROVIDES **FUNDING FOR TRIPS**

Many families view our Pizza Program as an opportunity to get out of making lunch once a week or think of it as a treat for the kids. And it is those things, but it's also a great fundraiser for School Council. In previous years the funds have gone toward an assortment of goals from purchasing new gym equipment to helping out with the costs of renovating the playground.

This year funds have been allocated to cover the cost of busing for one educational field trip per class. Busing costs are frightening and can be 50% or more of a field trip price tag for any out of town

destination. The cost of a single bus to Toronto runs as high as \$675, which typically works out to \$25 per student.

What this means for families is that for one of your child's field trips this year you will only be asked to cover the cost of admission to the destination. Not only will this give families a financial break but it also opens the door for teachers to plan more exciting trips without having to worry about an additional cost burden to families.

Allocation of funds from the program are determined at School Council meetings. All parents or quardians are always welcome to attend.

The festivities will commence at 6:30pm, with free hot chocolate being served until it runs out. Music will be played until 8pm.


The skating rink will remain open well after that time, so if you are able to bear the elements, you are welcome to skate well into the evening!
