Kicking off the 2021-22 Year

On Thursday, September 2, Grand Erie hosted a professional development day, with a focus on the launch of our new multi-year strategic plan. School teams were able to engage with the new Vision and Mission statements, as well as the key priorities of our new plan. Educators and leaders had an opportunity to come together and welcome each other back and review re-opening guidelines. Dr. Jean Clinton, Clinical Professor, Department of Psychiatry and Behavioural Neurosciences at McMaster, division of Child Psychiatry, delivered a

Balanced School Year Pilot Project Town Halls

Grand Erie is seeking to engage parents and guardians as it explores piloting a balanced school-year calendar in one of its Brantford elementary schools for the 2022-23 school year. Schools following a balanced school-year calendar have the same number of school days and holidays, but breaks are scheduled differently (or "balanced") throughout the school year. 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Grand Erie Partnering with Six Nations Polytechnic to Offer AQ Course for Educators

Grand Erie and Six Nations Polytechnic is offering an opportunity for educators to take part in the additional qualification course *Teaching First Nations, Metis, and Inuit Children,* providing an overview of First Nations, Metis, and Inuit perspectives as they relate to current classrooms in Ontario. This course is free to Grand Erie educators, and supports inquiry-based learning, honouring candidates' knowledge and lived experiences.
