Classroom Festivities

Some classrooms may engage in holiday festivities prior to the break. Individual teachers will communicate with families regarding plans for their class. If students are invited to bring in food items to share with the class, remember that any food items must be nut free. In addition, food items must be prepared in a health unit inspected kitchen or commercially prepared (BCHU policy). In some classes, there may be additional restrictions to accommodate food allergies within the classroom. All students will be invited to a school dance in the gym prior to the holidays. Grade groupings will be hosted at various times throughout the day.



Peanut/Nut Aware School

This is a peanut/nut aware school. Please do not send peanut based products, peanuts, or any nut products that may contain any of these items to the school. The safety of other children depends on this.

- Peanut butter substitutes are not allowed in elementary schools in GEDSB.
- Food is not permitted on the school playground at recess and at lunch.
 Students are permitted the opportunity to eat their snacks and lunches prior to going outside or immediately following the morning and afternoon recess periods.


