like this option to be eliminated from list, three attendees support this option and two unsure.

- (b) Kindergarten and Grade 8's moved to WDHS would reach the goal of 360 students at WPS. One parent voted yes to have this option remain on the list.
- (c) Kindergarten moved to WDHS with boundary adjustments would reach goal.
- (d) Grade 7 & 8's moved to WDHS with boundary adjustments would reach goal.
- (e) Recommendations that utilize WDHS would not be effective until 2024.
