- Pride of Place Grant was applied for last year fixed up 2 bathrooms, a new flag pole mechanism and one other improvement
- Plan to work with school council on a combined effort to improve the Learning Commons area
- SGG came in 2nd place for the battery return earning a cheque for \$2500
- Hot lunches will begin in October; pizza and pasta (new)
- Math Achievement Plan there will be a math coach in the school once per week working with students, teachers and classes

3.4 Treasurers report:

- Aug 2023 ended the school year at \$21, 410.85 in the account
- raised \$12,710.08 in revenue in 2022-23
- 2022-23 Expenditures totalled \$6,763.23
- 2022-23 total profit from fundraising events is: \$10,063.35
 - Grilled Cheese Profit = \$3,812.06
 - \circ Spirit Wear Profit = \$106
 - \circ Fun Fair Profit = \$4,503.92
 - \circ Other Fundraiser Profits Meet the Teacher, Krispy Kreme, Flora's, Mabels Labels = \$1,641.37
- put \$2,026 back into the school for Grade 8 Graduation and Division Funds (2 divisions applied and received)
- Rough budget being developed for 2023-24 being worked on and will be reviewed next meeting
