### **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

Courses required for graduation BY THE END OF GRADE 12:

- 4 credits in English
- 3 credits in Mathematics
- 2 credits in Science
- 1 credit in Canadian history
- 1 credit in Canadian geography
- 1 credit in the arts
- 1 credit in health and physical education
- 1 credit in French as a second language
- 0.5 credit in Career studies
- 0.5 credit in Civics

PLUS *one* credit from each of the following groups\*:

- **Group 1:** Additional credit in English or French, social science and the humanities or Canadian and World studies, or Guidance and career education, co-operative education\*\*
- **Group 2:** Additional credit in health and physical education, French, or the arts, or business studies, co-operative education\*\*
- **Group 3:** Additional credit in Science (grade 11 or 12) or French, or technological education, computer studies, co-operative education\*\*

\*where a credit is already listed in the list of compulsory courses, the group fulfillment is an *additional* credit in that area of study

\*\*Co-op can only be used to complete a maximum of 2 group requirements
