Mental Health and Well-Being Working Group:

Student Voice Working Group:

- Land Acknowledgment reviewing a consistent process across all schools
- Transition from Grade 8 to Grade 9 consideration for mentoring by senior students and sharing resources prior to starting grade 9
- De-streamed classes considerations for supporting students transitioning from grade 9 de-streamed to grade 10 courses
- Washroom Accessibility –would like to see more all-gender-neutral washrooms and opening more washrooms that have been closed
- School Cash Online new fees are an issue for some families; ensure there is a cash option for families who do not bank online

Environmental Working Group:

- Could more greenhouses be built? Nutrition classes could use the crops
- Can we implement compost bins?
- More signage on garbage and recycling bins would be helpful
- Biodegradable utensils should be used
- Promote more Eco Clubs schools that do have clubs need to advertise more
- Eco friendly projects pitching ideas to classes woodworking classes could build garbage cans and art classes could paint them
