
The <u>2025-2026</u> school year registration is now open Registration deadline: March 1, 2025

- Custody paperwork (if applicable)
- Copy of recent IEP (if applicable)

Proof of Home Address (provide 1 of the following):

- Current Property Tax Preferred
- Current Utility Bill
 - Current Purchase of Sale / Rental or Lease Agreement
 - Receipt from Landlord

A Driver's License cannot be used as proof of address

Academic Records:

- Recent high school transcript (current Gr. 9-12 students)
 - Recent school report card (Gr. 8-12)

What is the next step after submitting the documents?

Once all documentation is received and reviewed, a VP will contact families to set up appointments, if one is required. If your student is starting mid year or the registration is after the March deadline, it will require a meeting. Failure to provide ALL the forms/documents will delay your students start date.
