

**GRAND ERIE DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD
RELEASE OF INFORMATION FORM**

Access to an Ontario Student Record (OSR) means the right of those authorized by the Education Act to examine the contents of the OSR.

1.0 Students

Every student has a right of access to his or her OSR.

2.0 Parents and Guardians

A parent or guardian of a student who is not an adult has a right of access to the student's OSR.

3.0 Education Personnel

Only supervisory officers and the principal or teachers of the school staff have access to the OSR, for the purpose of improving the instruction of the students, without the written consent of the adult or of the parent(s) or guardian(s) of a student who is not an adult.

4.0 Other

No individual (including board officials) other than those identified previously in subsection 3.0 shall have access to the OSR without the written consent of the adult student or of the parent(s) or guardian(s) of a student who is not an adult.
