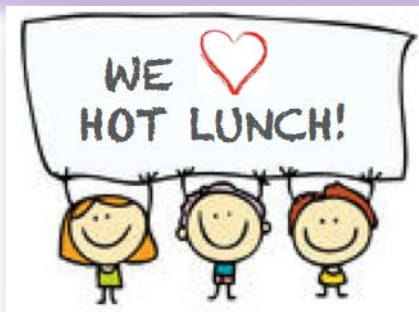

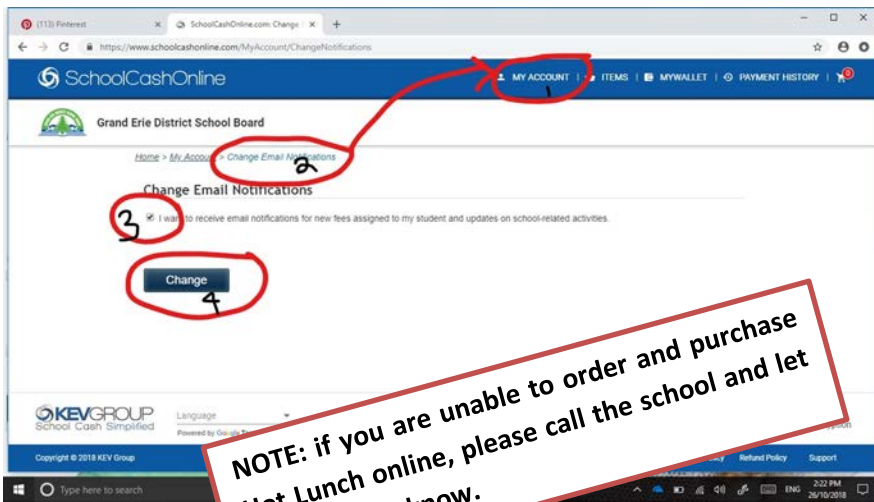


All staff on the school yard are now wearing brightly coloured safety vests in order to be easily seen by our students and each other.

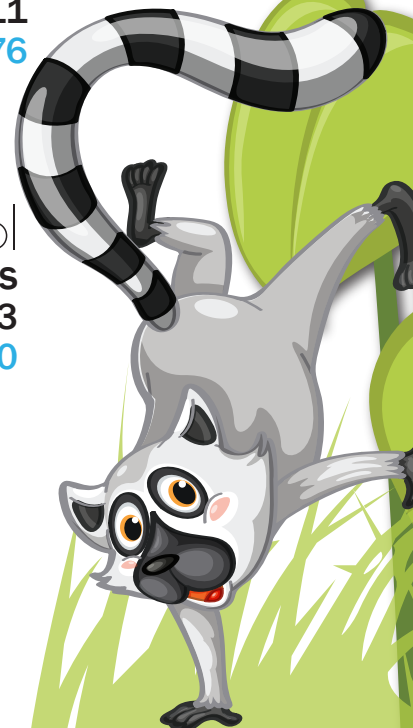

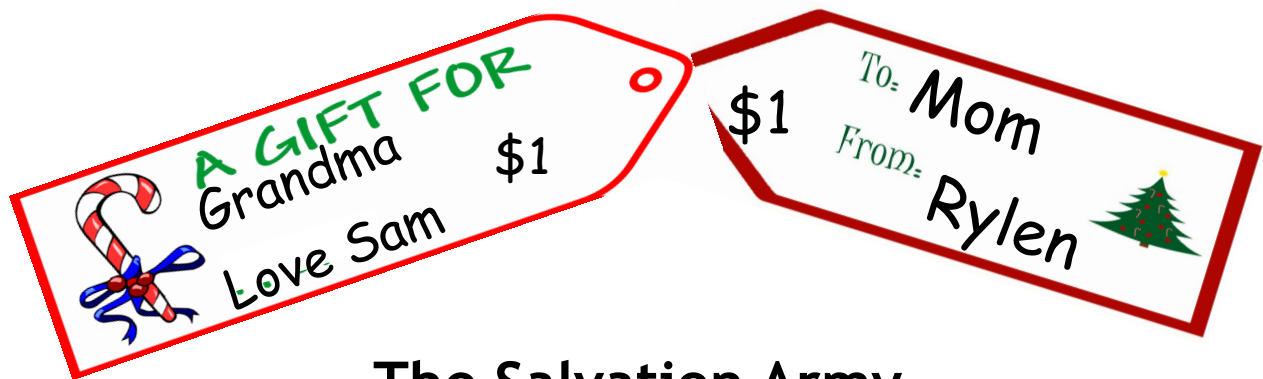
