

Language

We are focusing on retelling and summarizing fiction texts. This can be supported at home by asking your child to retell the story they have just read (or listened to) as well as asking for a few important facts from non-fiction texts.

Mathematics – Problem Solving (Grade 1)

Teaching in math has made a shift over the last few years to a problem solving model. We will be learning the steps in problem solving through a weekly math challenge during centre times in our class.

- Understand the problem.
 What are you being asked to figure out?
- 2. Come up with a plan. What math do you need to use? What tools do you need?
- 3. Carry out your plan.

Using these steps as our guide, we spend a lot of time sharing the processes we used to get to our answer. It's important to use the manipulatives to show how we solved it rather than a math formula.

SK friends will continue to grow their number knowledge through math games and our estimation station. If they are interested, they can attempt the Problem of the Week as well.
